Message: **Wow!**

Text: **Isaiah 6:1-8, Revelation 4:6-11**

*Then I heard what sounded like a great multitude,
like the roar of rushing waters and like loud peals of thunder, shouting: "Hallelujah! For

Connect:

Share a story of "wow!" Something that struck you with awe, wonder, beauty or worship.

Engage:

Read Isaiah 6:1-8 and Revelation 4:1-11

We say "Yes" and "Amen" to the truth of God. But we say "Wow," or "Hallelujah" to the glory of God. Is your worship more "Amen" or "Hallelujah?" Do you think a balance is preferred?

For Isaiah God goes from a concept (or impersonal being) to reality. And it "undoes" him. Has God become personal, or reality, to you? Have you been "undone" by God? Have you then been "born again" in Jesus? Have you heard the call of God and responded, "Here am I. Send me!" which is both the offering of yourself and your worship?

Apply:
