Message: **Jonah’s Rebellion**

Text: **Jonah 1:1-17, 2 Kings 14:23-25**

Connection Group Questions

Read Jonah 1:1-17. Pay attention to v. 1-6. *What did God ask Jonah to do? How did Jonah respond? Why was Jonah so against going to Nineveh?*

Sometimes our saying “no” to God more subtle than Jonah. *What does your disobedience (or half- obedience) look like, and what does it reveal regarding your beliefs about God?*

If you want to run from God, you will always find a ship (see v. 3). *What are some of the “ships” we run to when we want to run from God?*

Sin brings storms, both on us and onto other people. *How have you seen this to be true in your life?*

The good news for Christians is that God uses storms and enters into our storms. *How have you seen God work in the midst of your sin or difficult circumstances?*
